

CAMP MEADOWBROOK FAQ

When does camp start?

Our camp programs begin **June 8, 2026** and run through **August 14, 2026**.

Where is the camp located?

Camp Meadowbrook is located on The Meadowbrooks School campus at 1641 Hampton Rd, Meadowbrook PA 19001

What are your camp hours?

Each camp program may have a different schedule. Please review the Welcome Letter for your child's registered camp program.

What are the ages for your summer program?

Our programs are open to campers ages 3 to 12 years old. Please review our camp website for details on each program.

How many campers are in each program?

Most of our programs will not exceed 25-60 campers.

Are campers required to be potty trained?

Yes, campers must be potty trained in order to participate in all Camp Meadowbrook programs.

When does registration open?

Registration opens on **December 1st**.

When will I receive information regarding the camp I registered for?

Once you have registered for a camp program, you will receive a confirmation email. A Welcome Packet containing detailed information about your child's camp program will be emailed on **May 1st**.

Do you have a minimum number of weeks that my camper must attend?

Little Adventurers campers must register for at least 2 weeks of camp. You can select the weeks of your choice during registration. Campers for **Specialty camps** must register for the entire week of each program.

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What if my child cannot attend a full camp week or the full summer, can you accommodate schedule changes?

Yes, we can accommodate families that cannot attend a full summer or a full camp week. Prices are subject to change due to the schedule adjustment. Early bird rates do not apply to campers attending for a partial session.

Program Change Policy

In order to maintain the integrity of scheduling, staffing, and program preparation, all requests to modify existing registrations for the Summer Program are subject to the policy listed below.

Submission of Requests: All requests for changes to program dates, sessions, or activities must be submitted in writing via email to the program office.

Grace Period: Families are permitted one (1) change to their original registration without penalty.

Change Fee: Subsequent changes, or any changes requested after the grace period, will incur a **non-refundable change fee of \$25 per child, per change**. The first schedule change is FREE.

Deadline for Changes: No changes will be accepted within seven (7) days of the scheduled start date of the registered session.

Availability of Space: All changes are contingent upon space availability within the requested program or session.

Can I register for multiple camp programs?

Yes, you can register for multiple camp programs. Simply visit our camp page to check for availability of the program of your choice and register.

You may also send an email to summercamps@themeadowbrookschool.org with questions or assistance regarding registration.

Does camp provide lunch and snacks?

Campers can register for the summer lunch program or bring a bag lunch. We are a **nut aware** camp, therefore campers will be allowed to bring lunch with nuts. A

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designated table will be provided. Please do not send sugary juice or flavored water to camp. Campers must bring their own snack.

How can I sign up for the lunch program?

You may sign up for the lunch program when you register your child for camp.

What is served for lunch?

Lunch is prepared fresh each day by the Meadowbrook Schools CulinArt chefs. We serve a healthy lunch and dessert each day. Menus are provided throughout the summer.

What should my child bring to camp?

Each program requires different supplies, please review the Welcome Letter for your child's registered program.

General items campers should bring to camp everyday:

- 32 oz Water Bottle
- Sunscreen (spray sunscreen is preferred)
- Lunch (If your child is not registered for the summer lunch program)

Do you offer early registration discounts?

Yes, we offer Early Bird discounts on selected programs during the month of December. We also offer up to 10% sibling discount.

Do you offer camp scholarships or financial aid?

To help cover the cost of tuition, Camp Meadowbrook will award a limited amount up to \$1,000 financial aid awards to applying families. Families must complete an application by April 15th. What is the cost of each program?

Each program has a different price based on the length of the program and activities. Most of our programs range from \$375 to \$495 per week. Please review our camp website for program descriptions and prices.

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Are there options to set up a payment plan for my camp tuition?

To inquire about these options, please email the Business Manager at hsowden@themeadowbrookschoo.org. Payment plans require a credit card on file.

What is your cancellation policy?

If you withdraw a program, a refund will be applied according to the dates listed below:

90% refund until **March 15th** (10% processing fee will be applied)

40% refund until **April 15th** (10% processing fee will be applied). The refund policy applies to accounts that have been paid in full before the refund dates listed. **Camp deposits are non-refundable.**

What is your Counselor to Camper ratio?

The counselor to camper ratio for our *Little Adventurers* program is 1 Counselor/Instructor to every 8 campers, along with an Assistant and Junior Counselor for support. Additional counselors and support staff are available if needed. *Specialty Camps* will have 1 Counselor/Instructor for every 10 campers, along with an Assistant counselor and a Coach.

Who are the Camp Meadowbrook Staff?

Our summer staff consist of teachers, as well as college students studying to become teachers. Each staff member is required to submit the Pennsylvania Child Abuse clearance, PA State Police Criminal background checks, and FBI Fingerprinting.

Can we schedule a tour of the camp before we sign up?

Yes, families can schedule a tour of the campus. Please email our Camp Coordinator at ssullivan@themeadowbrookschoo.org to schedule.

What are your drop-off & pick-up procedures?

Morning Drop-Off

Parents must check-in their child at the designated entrance for their program. Signs will be placed throughout campus directing parents to each camp

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program. A Counselor will check-in your child upon arrival and direct them to their camp group. If arriving late, parents must call the office at [215-884-3238](tel:215-884-3238) prior to dropping off campers. A Counselor will assist you upon arrival.

Afternoon Pick-Up

Campers will be brought to their assigned location for pickup at the end of their program. Signs will be placed throughout campus directing parents to each camp program. All campers must be signed out before they will be released from camp.

Do you offer after care?

Extended Camp is currently not available for summer 2026.

What if my child misses a day of camp?

If your child will be absent please email summercamps@themeadowbrookschool.org to let us know. Please note that the camp fee for the day is non-refundable.

Is my child ready for summer camp?
