On behalf of the Board of Trustees and the Head of School Search Committee, I am very excited to announce that Mr. Jim Pierce has been unanimously selected as Meadowbrook's next Head of School beginning in July 2025.

Jim's appointment follows an extensive nationwide search that drew a pool of many impressive candidates. After Head of School Michael Reardon's announcement that he would be departing Meadowbrook in June 2025, the Board formed a Head of School Search Committee consisting of seven individuals – current and past parents, faculty, staff, and trustees. Currently, Jim serves as Math Improvement Facilitator and Principal at Reach Cyber Charter School, where he leads a team of 24 teachers serving over 900 upper elementary students. Prior to that, Jim served as the Chief Operating Officer and founding team member of YSC Academy, where he provided strategic leadership for daily operations of middle and upper school programs. Building on that dynamic path, Jim looks forward to an exciting next chapter at Meadowbrook. Jim holds B.A. in psychology and elementary education from Lycoming College, a master's degree in instructional technology and educational leadership from Drexel University, and will complete his Ed.D. in learning analytics from National University this spring.
